Kativik Ilisarniliriniq is a school board providing educational services in the 14 communities of Nunavik.

Function & Duties

Under the authority of the Director of School Operations, the School Principal is responsible for the administration of educational programs and teaching resources of an elementary or secondary school. The Principal is the educational leader of the school.

Qualifications

- Permanent teaching diploma (Brevet) issued by the Ministry of Education, Higher Education and Research (MEESR) or the equivalent from another Canadian province or a teaching authorization recognized under the Education Act for Cree, Inuit and Naskapi Native Persons (R.S.Q., c.1-14)
- A Bachelor's degree of Education or an undergraduate level in a relevant field of study certifying a minimum three-year university program, or hold a senior executive or senior staff position in a school board for which an undergraduate degree is required under the minimum qualifications or hold a position as a Vice-Principal;

The board may, at its discretion, waive any or all of the afore mentioned qualifications requirement if it finds a suitable candidate who is a beneficiary of the James Bay and Northern Quebec Agreement (JBNQA) and who accepts, as a condition of employment, to follow a training plan determined by the Board.

Requirements:

- 5-8 years of relevant experience
- Bilingualism in two of the three working languages of the Board (French, English, Inuktitut);



• Leadership experience in a multi-cultural environment will be considered an asset



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Classification / Salary / Benefits

Class 00-09 (from \$89,034 to \$118,709) or Class 00-10 (from \$94,183 to \$125,574) annually depending on the number of students, qualifications and experience.

In addition to salary, you may be eligible for benefits such as:

- 30 days of annual vacation
- Up to 10 days of personal leave/recuperation
- 2 weeks holiday leave

And when applicable, other benefits such as

- Summer hours;
- Housing;
- Northern allowance (between 10-20K);
- Social trips;
- Food transportation
